

<u>Terms of Participation in the t:graduate Program</u>

As a participant in the t:graduate program at the Technion, you are subject to all the rules, regulations, procedures, and instructions applicable to all graduate students at the Technion, including those of the School of Graduate Studies and the Technion's Intellectual Property Regulations.

However, the unique nature of the t:graduate program requires specific regulations to ensure a productive and successful experience for all participants. These regulations apply to all participants and serve as a condition for participation in the program. By joining the t:graduate program, you agree to abide by these regulations.

1. Collaboration and Teamwork

Participants are solely responsible for creating and managing their collaborations, research-based projects, and entrepreneurial initiatives. The program staff will not interfere with the formation, dissolution, or contributions of any collaboration and will not arbitrate or mitigate disputes.

2. External Mentors and Consultants

Academic mentors and business consultants contribute their time and expertise to the program voluntarily. The program staff may introduce participants to mentors/consultants, but the Technion and/or program staff bear no responsibility regarding any connection following such introductions.

3. Investor and Industry Relations


The program staff may introduce participants to potential investors, industry partners, or commercialization opportunities. The final decision regarding any investment, collaboration, or agreement rests solely with the participants and the external parties involved. The Technion and/or the program staff bear no responsibility regarding such connections.

4. Third-Party Service Providers

Participants may choose to use third-party service providers (for example: legal, financial, technical, or any other services) to support their projects. The program staff may provide recommendations, but the final decision and responsibility rest solely with the participants.







5. Intellectual Property

6. Confidentiality

During the program, participants may be exposed to confidential information, research data, trade secrets, and/or intellectual property belonging to other participants or collaborators.
